- I. School fees are paid annually or in three terms per academic year (except for boarding students). Prices are revised in Term 2 for the next academic year.
- II. All fees, charges, extracurricular clubs, extension period (€70/month), optional classes, residential school trips etc. must be paid by direct debit.
- III. A non-refundable application Fee of € 250 is charged per family making a formal application to the school. This fee is due to be paid prior to any application being handled (applicable for new families joining King's College School, Cascais).
- IV. Once your child has been accepted, a non-refundable Enrolment Fee of €2.000 (Early Years 1 to Year 6) or €5.000 (from Year 7) is required to secure your child's place at the school. No reimbursement will be made in case of cancellation of a place at any time. (applicable for new students joining King's College School, Cascais).
- V. An annual re-enrollment fee (€550) will be charged and will be debited in April, unless parents state on the re-enrollment form their intention not to do so by February 29th.
- VI. Families are referred to the declaration they signed on the school application form stating that they would abide by the conditions of the school, including the payment of fees and charges.
- VII. King's College School, Cascais has a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program: a follow up email will be sent in this regard.

Boarding

- I. The Boarding fees are additional to the tuition fees. The amount for the 2024/25 academic year is €23.965.
- II. 50% of tuition and the boarding fees should be paid at the time of enrollment. The remaining 50% should be paid by the 1st of September.
- III. Boarding Fees include stay in a double boys' or girls' bedroom (including single bed, private WC, and a study area), cleaning service, laundry service, weekday dinners, weekend meals, full week breakfast, use of the school sports center, access to common areas and Wi-Fi connection.
- IV. Boarding fees do not include the tuition fee, school uniform, extra and non-educational residential trips, extracurricular activities, (I)GCSE exams, Laptop, and other Personal Educational Materials.
- V. New boarding student admission fee is €1.000.
- VI. Weekend extracurricular activities are included in the fees, although some optional events and activities will come at an extra cost.
- VII. A limited EAL and SEN provision is included for all boarding (to be discussed and determined at the time of admission / re-enrollment).
